








# FAMILY RULES

**Church is like family. As a family, we love gathering together.**

Our gatherings will have to look a little different from what we're used to. Here are a few simple "family rules" that will help us gather in a way that welcomes and respects everyone.

	<b>Registration</b>	We'll all need to plan ahead and pre-register for our Sunday gatherings (by Saturday noon, please). You can register through our Planning Center app (or by email to <a href="mailto:office@hepburnmb.com">office@hepburnmb.com</a> ).
	<b>Seating</b>	Once registered you will be assigned seating in your family group. Please respect the boundaries marked out and follow the instructions of the ushers and the service leaders.
	<b>Distance</b>	Let's respect one another by keeping a 2 metre distance from others. We will do our best to implement this and we ask that you do your best, and we will figure this out together. (This does mean no hugs or handshakes. 😞) We ask that you keep this mind when you're visiting outside as well.
	<b>Signage</b>	We will have signs in place to help us move around the building. It'll be best for everyone if we follow these. If you have any questions, please ask an usher.
	<b>Masks</b>	You are welcome here whether you wear a mask or not. We will be asking adults and youth to put on a mask for our singing times. Masks are available at the registration table if you need one.
	<b>Clean Hands</b>	Let's do our best to keep our hands clean. You will find hand sanitizing stations throughout the building. Feel free to use as much as you feel is necessary.
	<b>Self-screening</b>	We're all used to this one. Stay home if you are feeling sick (fever, cough, sore throat, runny nose, or shortness of breath), have tested positive for Covid-19, are a close contact of a person who has tested positive for Covid-19, or if you travelled outside of Canada within the last 14 days.
